Meeting Minutes

August 8, 2016

I. Call to order

Supervisor Hooper called to order the regular meeting of the Hinsdale Town Board at 7: pm on August 8, 2016 at The Town Board Room.

III. Approval of minutes from last meeting

Clerk Carr presented the minutes from the last meeting. The minutes were approved as presented on a Motion from Councilman Maerten, seconded by Councilman Wilson Ayes All.

IV. Supervisors Report: Received July 2016

V. Highway Supt. Report: have been digging ditches. Redding road will be widened and regraded where needed. Button Rd. will be rolled to try to level out the washboard. Chips money has been used all but \$9,500.

- b) Supervisor Hooper will speak with Town Attorney Burke regarding Allegany's noise ordinance and if it would be possible to adopt something similar for Hinsdale.
- c) Councilman Wilson has been looking into the Boat Launch issue and has discovered that the DOT owns the land.
- d) The Vacant property on Main St. is owned by Chase bank and Supervisor Hooper is looking onto what can be done to keep it mowed.
- e) Motion made to for the \$5.00 Dog Enumeration fee to take effect October 1, 2016 for all new dogs licensed, made by Councilman Wilson, Seconded by Councilman Noll Ayes all.

XII. New business

- a) The insurance agent from NY MIR was here and wanted the Town to weed whack and trim the bushes out front of the Town Hall because of safety issues. Councilwoman Powley is looking into having someone trim them for us.
- b) Resident Moore asked if all Board meetings were being posted in the paper. Supervisor Hooper will look into making sure they are all posted as per the Open Meeting Law.
- c) Board had agreed to let Clerk Carr appoint Dog Enumeration People as needed. So far we have Eric Page, Justin Carr And Shawn Granger along with our Dog Control Officers.
