

Hinsdale Town Board

Meeting Minutes

October 8, 2018

I. Call to order

Supervisor Bishop called to order the regular meeting of the Hinsdale Town Board at 7:02pm on October 8, 2018 at the Town Board Room. The pledge was recited.

II. Roll call

The following persons were present: Monroe Bishop - Supervisor, Ronald Brown, MaryAnn Powley, Joseph Noll, Douglas Wilson- Board members, Ann Carr- Town Clerk, Robert Nupp- Deputy Dog Control Officer, Greg Church- Water Dept. III. Approval of minutes from last meeting

Clerk Carr presented the minutes from the last meeting. The minutes were approved as presented by a motion from Councilman Wilson. Seconded by Councilman Noll. Ayes All.

IV. Supervisor's Report: Received Aug. & Sept. 2018

V. Highway Supt. Report: read by Supervisor Bishop Stated that

- a) The Hwy has been chipping Redding rd., Isaman rd., Town Line Rd, and part of Elling Rd.
- b) Patching other roads.
- c) Hauling millings from Rt. 446 and the extension in Olean.

XI. Open issues

- a) Water Hydrant on Flanigan rd. is in and fixed. Water Supt. Church would like to thank Rick Foster for helping out.
- b) The Water Dept. is in need of a Pipe Locator and a Hydrant meter. Supt Church asked for it to be put in the budget for next year.

- c) Clerk Carr received a quote from TPS propane for this season of \$149.9. She was to check with two other suppliers and to renew TPS contract if they were the lowest quote.
- d) The Snowplow is in for the Sidewalk tractor. It will be finished and delivered this month.
- e) Councilwoman Powley asked if the Towns name was on the Highway trucks yet. It was suggested to contact a local resident who has done the signing before.
- f) Pat Ash representing the Historical Society asked permission for the Use of the Main St. Park for the Christmas Tree Display in Dec. and Jan. as was done last year.
- g) Getting the electric fixed for the Park on Main St. which was tabled at a previous meeting was again brought up. It is needed for the Christmas tree display. Councilman Brown said he would look into it and get a quote from an electrical inspector.
- h) Rick Ellman has given the Town an estimate of \$1,100.50 for installing the outlets on posts to plug the truck into this winter. A copy has also been sent to the insurance company.
- i) A meeting with Levi Feely about the New Hwy garage revealed it would be cheaper to make the barn all one size rectangle, rather than one end smaller than the other.

XII. New business

- a) There will be a Budget workshop on Oct. 18, 2018 at 7pm in the Town Board Room. Clerk Carr will put in paper and website.
- b) There will be a Public Hearing for the 2019 budget on Nov. 12, 2018 at 6:30pm with the Regular Town Board meeting to follow.
- c) The New York State Troopers have contacted Supervisor Bishop on the possibility of building a new State Troopers barracks and Forensic lab in Hinsdale possibly on Town Property. The Town Board was agreeable to the proposition.
- d) Blue Cross Blue Shield renewal has to be done by Dec. 01,2018
- e) Progressive Energy contacted the Town in regards to giving the Town quotes for Electric service. The Board was not interested.
- f) Hwy Supt. Mascho has asked Supervisor Bishop for a light to be installed on the side on the Highway barn where the Trucks will be parked this winter. The Board said to ask Rick Ellman to give quote and complete it when he does the other work there.

- g) A resident inquired about how far the Towns right of way was from the center of the road because he was having trouble with a neighbor about parking on the side of the road. He was informed it was 24ft 9 inches from the center of the road.

XIII. Motion to pay the bills with the exception of Voucher # 198 which was tabled until next month made by Councilman Noll. Seconded by Councilman Brown. Ayes all.
